The eleven-unit project at 24601 Hawthorne (North side of Via Valmonte & Hawthorne) sent in a traffic study to the city of Torrance, and expects an environmental assessment in Mid-March, which will start a 30 day public comment period. The city of RHE has said they will watch for that and comment as appropriate.

The Rockbluff Park play equipment is the subject of a P&A subcommittee. They plan to send out a questionnaire to the community. We are unsure how they plan to distribute the questionnaire.

COMMUNITY APPEARANCE: (Warren Arata)

Sidewalk repair activity is over for now, will resume in 2022.

The pine tree at the top of Rockbluff has had more discussion, no action yet. Bennett will trim the Kingspine fountain grass.

RHE will review the dead oleander next to the Silver Spur footpath.

RHE plans to replace the ~20 trees removed this spring in our neighborhood.

The new Rockbluff Park play equipment will be confined to the current sand area. The community will be surveyed on their preferences for the play equipment.

MEMBERSHIP: Juanita Stucker

Our recent real estate activity is one house on Rockbluff sold, and two houses on Elmdale in escrow. Juanita visited three new residents, including the new residents on Rockbluff.

NEWSLETTER: Jim Knauf

Jim received feedback on our website from Doug and Richard. He is shooting for March 31 for the next newsletter. Topics will include the Rockbluff Park playground equipment, the GPAC, the sidewalk repair, Neighborhood Watch, welcoming new residents.
